David Astley "Ambulance Service".

David Astley, OBE, is the Chairman of SECAmb, the South East Coast Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust. If you have ever had to call for an ambulance these are the people you would have spoken to and who would have come to help you.

The trust currently serves a population of around 5 million and covers an area of 3,600 square miles across Kent, Surrey, Sussex and parts of NE Hampshire and includes us here in Meopham. The service provided these days is far more complex than the minimal hospital transportation service that ambulances traditionally provided. Today SECAmb includes operations centres, 111 call centres, 120 ambulance stations and two hazardous areas response teams and employs among others paramedics, technicians, dispatchers and clinicians.

David will explain how this all fits together and how the role of these health care professionals and those from the other emergency services meld together to serve the 318 people who phone daily for a SECAmb ambulance whilst also working to find solutions to growing and changing demand.

Meopham Speedwatch Scheme are looking for volunteers to support them in reducing speed and improving the safety on their roads with the support of the police.

Speedwatch is a community-based scheme where volunteers record speed of passing vehicles in the area where they live. Around **90%** of vehicles observed once by Speedwatch volunteers are not seen speeding again in the next 12 months within Kent.
