"Ellen Terry - The First Superstar" - Ann Rachlin MBE

Ann Rachlin MBE, is a pioneer of music appreciation for children in the UK, and the founder of "Fun With Music". A gifted storyteller, she began teaching music appreciation in London before creating "Fun with Music". She is a published author of children's books and, most importantly for us, an authority on Dame Ellen Terry, the great Victorian actress, and Ellen's daughter Edith Craig. Ann is a Fellow of Grey College, University of Durham.

During her talk Ann will tell us about the astonishing life and times of Dame Ellen whose colourful personal life, far from alienating her from the public, led to her being adored by the masses and considered to be the leading Shakespearean and comic actress in Britain. Dame Ellen has a local connection, in that she lived in her later years at Smallhythe Place, near Tenterden, Kent. The house is now in the care of the National Trust and you may care to visit it.

The meeting will be followed by refreshments and member's time in the Church rooms.
